Without appropriate intervention, 74% of children diagnosed with learning differences will continue to experience reading difficulties into adulthood.

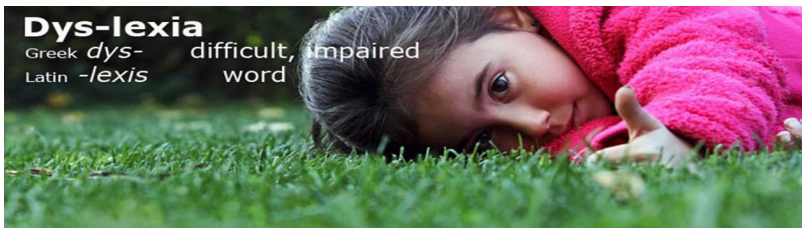
